ZILLMERE STATE SCHOOL Uniform Policy

Zillmere State School is a uniform school. Both the school and the P&C Association support the view that all children will wear the correct uniform and expect that parents enrol their children at this school on the understanding that the full uniform will be worn at all times.

Expectations and Dress Code for Zillmere State School

- Students are expected to wear the school uniform. (polo shirt and shorts)
- A bucket hat is essential, preferably the school design and colour.
- White ankle socks.
- Shoes must be a fully enclosed school shoe or jogger.
- Hair should be neatly groomed. (Dyed, bleached, or shaved hair is not appropriate).
- The only jewellery permitted is a watch and one sleeper or stud in each ear.
- This school has a no hat, no play policy. Children not wearing hats must remain in the undercover areas of the school during breaks. A bucket hat must be worn for protection against the sun. Caps and visors do not provide sufficient protection from the sun. Hats are available for purchase from the tuckshop/uniform shop at a cost of \$15.00.
